Ideas for Use

- Arrange the cards on a key ring so you can easily flip through them each day.
- Place your stack of cards by your bed to read the prayers at either the beginning or end of your days.
- Hold onto the prayers that resonate with you. Display those prayers in a place where you will see them often so you can read the prayers again and again.

Printing Instructions

Print the daily devotional cards on 8.5x11 sheets of card stock under portrait orientation, double-sided, and choose “long edge to long edge,” or “flip on long edge,” for the correct layout. When printed double-sided, there will be eight sheets with eight cards each. Cut the sheets into 62 devotional cards per person. The cards are numbered and intended to be used in a particular order.

Tip: You can also print the cards on [this perforated paper](#) to easily tear the cards apart.
